CANCER SUPPORT VI

Education • Information • Assistance



Cancer Support VI (CSVI) was founded by International Capital & Management Company (ICMC) in 2005. We initially met with a group of 45 cancer survivors and patients asking them what they would like to have us provide in a cancer support group. They answered: information—about the latest treatment options, complementary treatments and nutrition. We have based this group on these requests.

The support group began just prior to the opening of the Charlotte Kimelman Cancer Institute (CKCI).



CSVI LECTURE SERIES

CSVI provides professional speakers once a month to address topics of interest to cancer patients, survivors, their care givers, family and friends. These lectures are free of charge and open to the public. ICMC brings in oncologists, cancer specialists, naturopaths, nutritionists, Qi Gong instructors, acupuncturists, psychologists, lawyers and other healthcare professionals to address the group.

CSVI CANCER PATIENT FUND

The CSVI Cancer Patient Fund is set up with the Community Foundation of the VI. There is a \$2000 cap per patient per year.

- Provides funds for uninsured and needy VI cancer patients
- Can cover initial medical treatment, tests, etc. as patients are set up with Medical Assistance (MAP).
- Can help cover hotel accommodations, car rental etc. for patients traveling for treatment
- Covers hospice care
- Assistance with bills
